Instamatic 133

The Kodak Instamatic 133 was a 126 cartridge film camera introduced by Kodak Ltd, Kodak AG and Kodak Spain in 1968, designed by Alexander Gow. The 133 had a flashcube socket, shutter speed of 1/80 sec. (sunlight), 1/40 sec. (dim light or flash) the lens was 1: 11/43mm fixed focus. Three different types of film can be used in this camera: Kodacolor-x film, Kodachrome-x film and verichrome pan film.
