Kodak Instamatic Trimlite 28

The Trimlite 28 was produced in 1975-1979. It is an auto-exposure fixed-focus camera with a Flip flash socket and a tripod socket. The sliding lens cover shows a warning flag in the bright-line viewfinder when closed, but does not lock the shutter. This camera was also packed with an "Ektron II" electronic flash unit and marketed as the "Big Flash 28". The lens is f/8 25mm with shutter speed of 1/30 and 1/160. The film type is 110 with picture size of 13 x 17mm. The original price was USD 61.00.
