## Praktica FX

The Praktica FX was produced in September 1952 to February 1954 by VEB Kamera-Werke Niedersedlitz. There was 29 532 cameras produced.

The shutter is mechanically controlled horizontal-run rubberised cloth-blind type shutter with twin settings for fast and slow speeds. Exposure times:  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{5}$ ,  $\frac{1}{10}$ ,  $\frac{1}{50}$ ,  $\frac{1}{100}$ ,  $\frac{1}{200}$ ,  $\frac{1}{500}$ . The viewfinder is a fixed waist-level with condenser type ground-glass focusing screen, simple sports view finder. Film advance is a knob on camera, loose film take-up spool (metal) and manual frame counter. The lens mount is M42x1. The flash is X- and F-synchronisation with three flash contacts at the front of the camera body.
